FOREWORD

Signs and wonders are a key way in which God communicates, confirms, and bears witness of His presence. While I am pleased and get excited at God moving in the gifts of healings and the working of miracles, I believe that we are in a day when the signs and wonders of God will be poured out in various ways through His Body. Chapter 1 The WORD

It is obvious from these Scriptures that God's desire is to communicate Himself to mankind. In Hebrews the first chapter we receive the witness that God has spoken to mankind in times past by the prophets. God specifically chose men and women of various backgrounds, circumstances, experiences, personalities, etc., to be His mouthpiece, to speak His Word, and to proclaim His message. These men and women communicated the mind, will, emotions, and heart of the True and Living God. They were witnesses to the people of God's desire for their lives.

Think of it! God gracing man, endowing man, partnering with man, choosing man to communicate His will—the eternal God, communicating His Word through temporal man. Look at people like Moses, study characters like Elijah, meditate on people like Isaiah, and you will begin to comprehend God's ultimate desire to communicate to people Who He is. The zenith of God's communication to mankind was Christ Himself, the Son, and the First Begotten. In times past, God has spoken to the fathers our fathers—by the prophets; but in our day, in our time, He has spoken to us by the Son. So often when we read the Scripture, we think of Christ's coming in the flesh. Let me suggest to you that it is Christ's coming in the flesh that is emphasized here, but it is through the coming of Christ in a corporate Body of Believers by His Spirit that God speaks to mankind.

Christ is called the First Begotten of God. Understand, He is the First Begotten of many brethren. He was the seed that was sown for God to reap a family of sons and daughters in His image and after His likeness. God not only desired to communicate words, but to communicate Himself—the Word—to men and women. This communication is not limited to speaking, but the impartation of the Life of God into jars of clay, transforming the jars of clay into a Temple made without hands, holy, magnificent, filled with God by the Holy Spirit.

John, the first chapter, reveals to us the very character of God. God is a God of communication. In His preincarnate state, Yeshua was called the Word. How much more clearly can God reveal His nature to communicate than to name Himself the Word? *And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only Begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth* (John 1:14).

Yeshua said in the Scriptures that when we see Him, we see the Father. The Bible lets us know in

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Colossians that it pleased God that the fullness of the Godhead would dwell in Christ bodily. Think about this. The fullness of the Godhead dwelling in Christ. The Bible lets us know that we are His Body. If we are His Body, then it pleases God for the fullness of the Godhead to dwell in the many-membered Body of Christ **bodily**. This is beyond our current teaching, doctrine, and theology, but a revelation that God is bringing to His people in this time.

Rick Joyner, in his book, *FINAL QUEST*, speaks about the powers of the age to come. This is walking in that power. It may look like we will never get there, that it is impossible for man, but all things are possible unto God.

God desires for us to walk in total unity, total revelation, and total communion with Him and each other by His Spirit. This is His design, this is His plan from the beginning. The Bride of Christ will be those who walk in this experientially. The Lord shared with me a couple of years ago, that as the Day of the Coming of the Lord approaches, He will allow His servants to take excursions into Heaven and bring back a timely message to prepare the Bride of Christ for the time of His visitation.

In order to entrust us with this level of revelation, God has to prove, to test, His people and conform us into

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the image of His Son. His ultimate intention is to replicate, duplicate, and create more christs. Our current theology is so self-centered and so man-centered that we can't believe that this is possible, but it is His intention. He is sending out a clarion call to those who have an ear to hear what the Spirit is saying to the Churches. What our apostolic forefathers modeled and experienced was the beginnings of this. Paul revealed in Ephesians, the fourth chapter, that God's goal is to bring us to the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ. This can and will be accomplished by God endowing us with a measure of His Spirit that mankind has not yet experienced.

God has gone through pains-taking efforts to even communicate to us through the natural creation. As we just read, the Heavens declare the glory of God. God has so created the Heavens and His natural creation that when we approach this creation with a pure heart, it proclaims resoundingly GOD! This language, communicated by creation, is above every human language. As it says in Psalm 19, there is no speech or language where their voice (the Heavens and the firmament) is not heard.

Paul says in the first chapter of Romans that men are without excuse because God's physical creation speaks clearly of the invisible God. Many Christians today do believe that God speaks, but have not developed an intimate relationship with God whereby there is consistent communication from God to them. Much of our communication with God is us speaking to Him in prayer, making petitions, asking for our desires. God desires to teach us how to be quiet and listen to His voice. We need to learn the various ways that God speaks, or more accurately, communicates His purpose, plan, and will for Himself to and through us.

God is speaking. *God is speaking*. *God is speaking*! Shall we have an ear to hear? The Great Communicator is communicating to us. Shall we be open to receive? In the following chapters, we will look at the ways God speaks. This book is not designed to be an exhaustive list, but as a beginning to make us aware of the divers ways in which God communicates. I ask that you read it meditatively, openly, and asking for the guidance and leading of His precious Spirit Who has been given unto us to teach us all things. May God richly bless your study of Him, the Great Communicator.
